GET TRACING...

Wow another great activity for you to get practicing tracing numbers with you finger and counting the dots to find the number you need to draw

WHAT YOU NEED-

- Tray
- Salt/sand
- Paper
- Pen
- Scissors



HOW TO DO IT:

1. Fill a small tray with salt or sand
2. Ask your child to count the dots to reveal the number you have drawn on the paper
3. Ask your child to use their finger draw the matching number in the salt/sand. If they find this tricky you can model the number in the mixture first. Ask the child to trace the number before covering it up.
4. Now ask your child to have another go.

GET MATCHING...

What a great way to match stones or other items you can find when out on a walk or in your home.

WHAT YOU NEED –

- Paper
- Stones
- Pen



HOW TO DO IT:


1. Collect different sized and shaped stones
2. Trace around them on the paper using your pen
3. Place all the stone into a pile
4. Ask your child to match the correct stone into the markings you made on the paper

GET CREATIVE...

We love to read the rainbow fish and how he shared his special scales with other fish, why not try and make you our rainbow fish

WHAT YOU NEED-

- Coloured paper,
- Pens
- Scissors
- Bubble wrap
- Paint
- Paint brush
- Foil
- Glue



HOW TO DO IT-

1. Draw a fish outline on some bubble wrap and then cut it out using scissors
2. Using the different paint you have chosen colour the bubble wrap in different colours
3. Once painted get a plain piece of paper and press the bubble wrap down onto the paper
4. Remember you need to press down on the bubble wrap to print the paint
5. Once you have pressed the bubble wrap carefully lift it off and let it dry
6. Using the glue and scissors cut out a fin or scales to add to the fish.
